In addition to the survey, the School Board will hold a public hearing October 12, 2009, 7:00 p.m., in the board room of the Pulaski County School Board Office, 202 N. Washington Avenue, Pulaski, VA.**

**“Hiring a new superintendent is among the most important responsibilities of a School Board. We want to make sure that the public has a voice in this process,” said School Board Chairman, Paul Phillips. “We hope that parents, staff and residents of Pulaski County will take time to fill out the survey or attend the public hearing.”**
